Please find attached the 2017 annual report of Samruk-Kazyna Trust Social Development Foundation. We have prepared this report, being guided by the best international practices, and integrated the most advanced approaches to the preparation of the accounts. In 2017, Samruk-Kazyna Trust was set an important task to develop an effective mechanism of social investment – “a give-back and sustainable charity”. The Foundation implemented the project management principles with a focus on financial expediency and improvement of project deliverables. Thus, the quality of projects was improved significantly and the cost of their implementation was optimized. Last year, we implemented 64 projects. More than 300 000 people all over Kazakhstan became the direct beneficiaries. By comparison, in 2016 we implemented 89 projects for about 200 000 people. The number of projects reduced, but all of them were oriented on the organization of the system work in the social sector. First of all, Samruk-Kazyna Trust built a close cooperation with the Government of the Republic of Kazakhstan, thereby having excluded the duplication of functions of the governmental agencies and making its activity comply with the priorities of the government policy. The Foundation keeps working on strengthening its relations with non-governmental organizations

of the country as the key partners in administration of the social projects. In 2017, Samruk-Kazyna Trust acted as an initiator of social changes and developed a unique regional social investment program known as “Menin Elim”. The program combined a number of projects focused on the improvement of the quality of life in the regions, where the member companies of the Foundation operate.

In this annual report we present a new approach to projects, and that is why we conditionally divided them in four sections. In the first section “Care” we will tell you about socially important projects providing support to the population. In “Impulse” you will see projects giving people momentum to achieve new heights. The “Development” is about supporting the initiatives focused on the comprehensive development of people of Kazakhstan, and in the “Movement” you will find a description of sports projects aimed at making mass sports popular, especially among the young generation.

We stay committed to our key principles: efficiency, consistency, transparency and social importance. Our Foundation takes all responsibility for the imposed functions, strives to achieve the goals of sustainable social development and improvement of the quality of life in our country.

ABOUT THE FOUNDATION

GENERAL INFORMATION

The activities of Samruk-Kazyna Trust Social Development Foundation go hand in hand with the strategy of its founder, group of companies of Samruk-Kazyna JSC, which sets the tasks on integration of the sustainable development and social responsibility principles in the

business development plan. The presence of the group of companies in most regions of Kazakhstan certainly makes us committed: to date, more than 400 companies with about 340,000 employees are members of the Foundation.

was observed, currently the Foundation applies targeted solutions to problems in various locations. Today, the Foundation demonstrates stable results of qualitative changes in its governance and charity administration system.



SAMRUK-KAZYNA TRUST COMPLETELY REFORMED ITS APPROACH TO CHARITY, HAVING TRANSITIONED FROM TARGETED ASSISTANCE TO THE INTRODUCTION OF SOCIAL INVESTMENT

In 2017, this step made it possible to increase the total number of direct beneficiaries and cover the interests of more people in the regions of Kazakhstan, both among employees of the group of companies and regional communities not directly involved in the operations of Samruk-Kazyna group of companies.

The single operator acts under the support of the Republic of Kazakhstan Government, state agencies, local executive authorities and experts in public and social policies. The non-governmental organizations act as administrators of the Foundation's charity projects.

Built a system of QUALITATIVE SELECTION AND CONTROL of socially important projects;

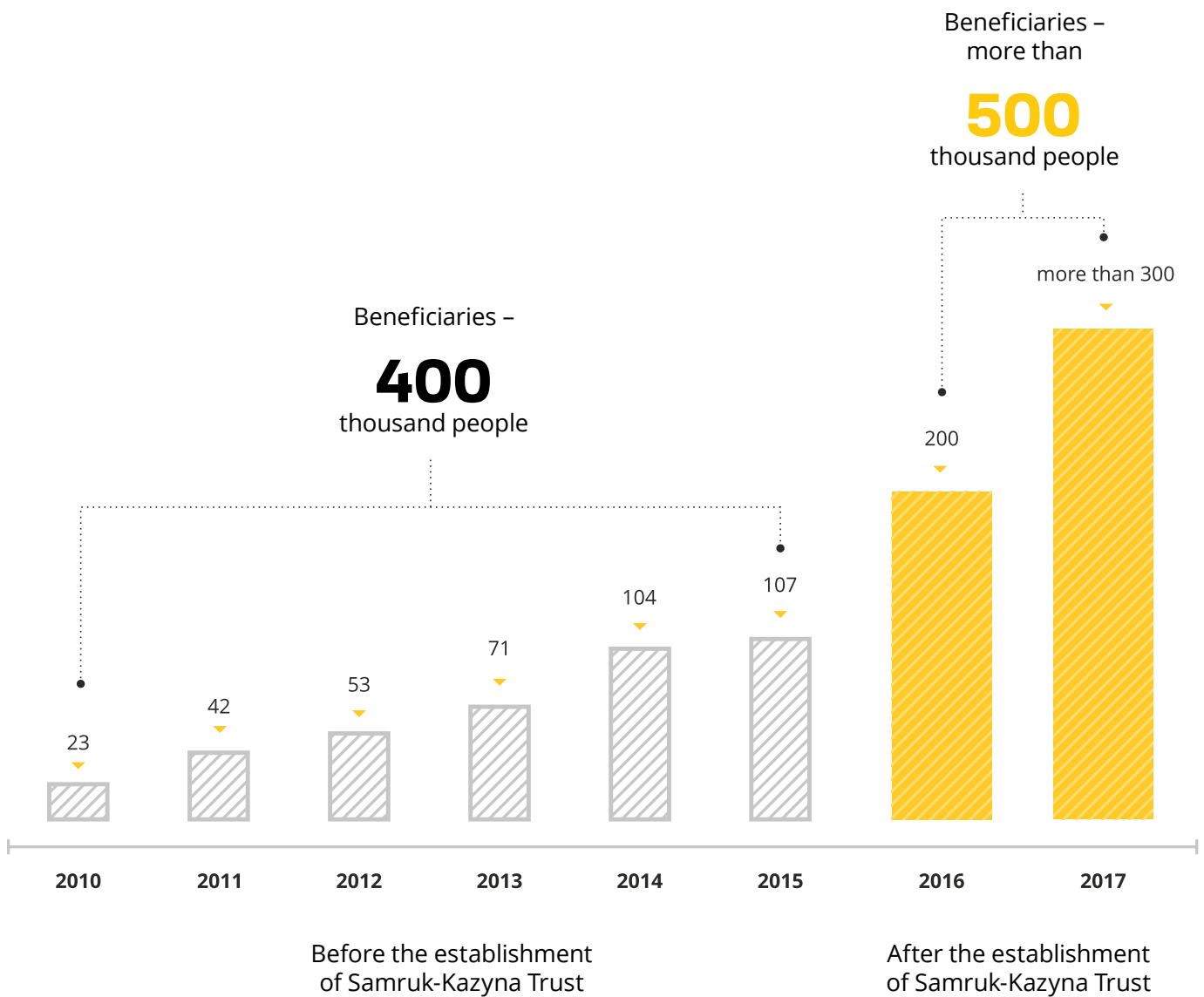
Established TRANSPARENT decision making and financing procedures;

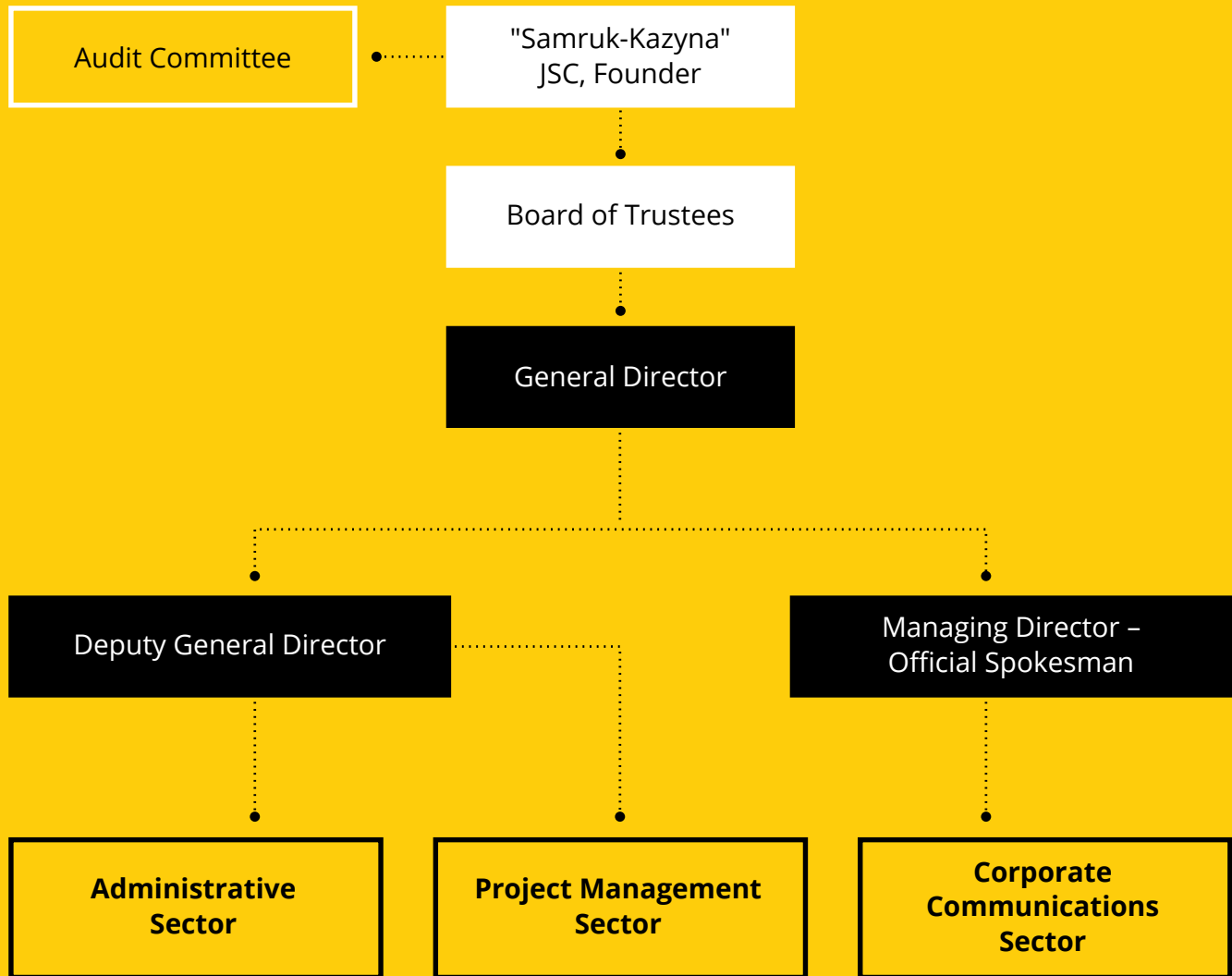

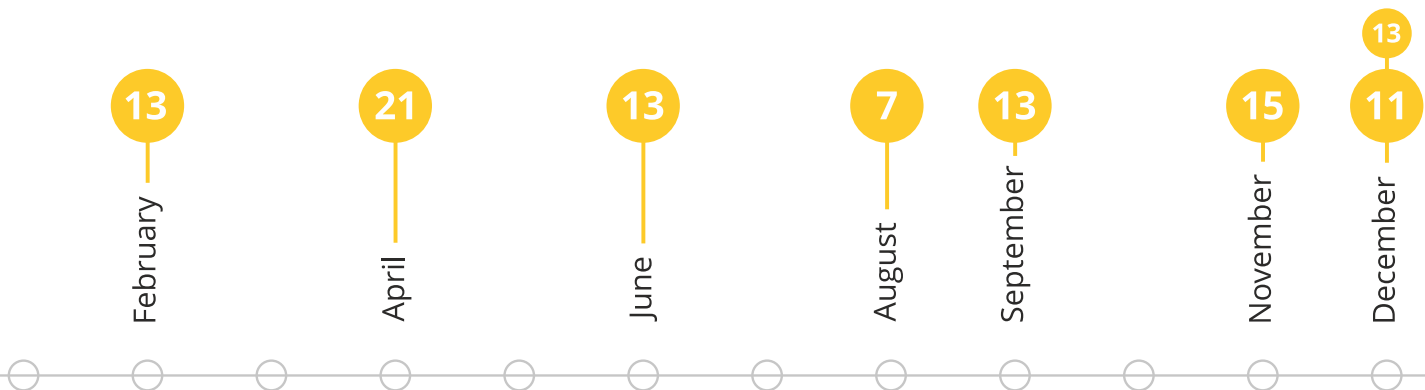
The Board of Trustees is a permanent collegial management body of Samruk-Kazyna Trust Social Development Foundation, which

SYSTEM FOR PROCESSING THE APPLICATIONS

Samruk-Kazyna Trust considers applications filed by individuals and legal entities, performs their expert assessment and prepares a reply in accordance with the procedure established by the laws of the Republic of Kazakhstan.

According to Article 8 of the Procedure for Consideration of Applications of Individuals and Legal Entities Act of the Republic of Kazakhstan No. 221-III, the applications of individuals and legal entities are processed

within 15 calendar days after their receipt. An application for which additional information is required from other parties is processed within 30 calendar days after its receipt.

The applications for charitable assistance that comply with the Charity Provision and Monitoring Regulations of Samruk-Kazyna Trust are forwarded for consideration to the Board of Trustees.

In 2017, Samruk-Kazyna Trust received 1,324 applications, of which:

194 – applications for charitable assistance from non-governmental organizations of the Republic of Kazakhstan.

42 – of which were approved.

152 – applications found to be noncompliant with the Charity Provision and Monitoring Regulations of Samruk-Kazyna Trust.

1130 – incoming correspondence from the state agencies, local executive authorities, internal correspondence with charity users

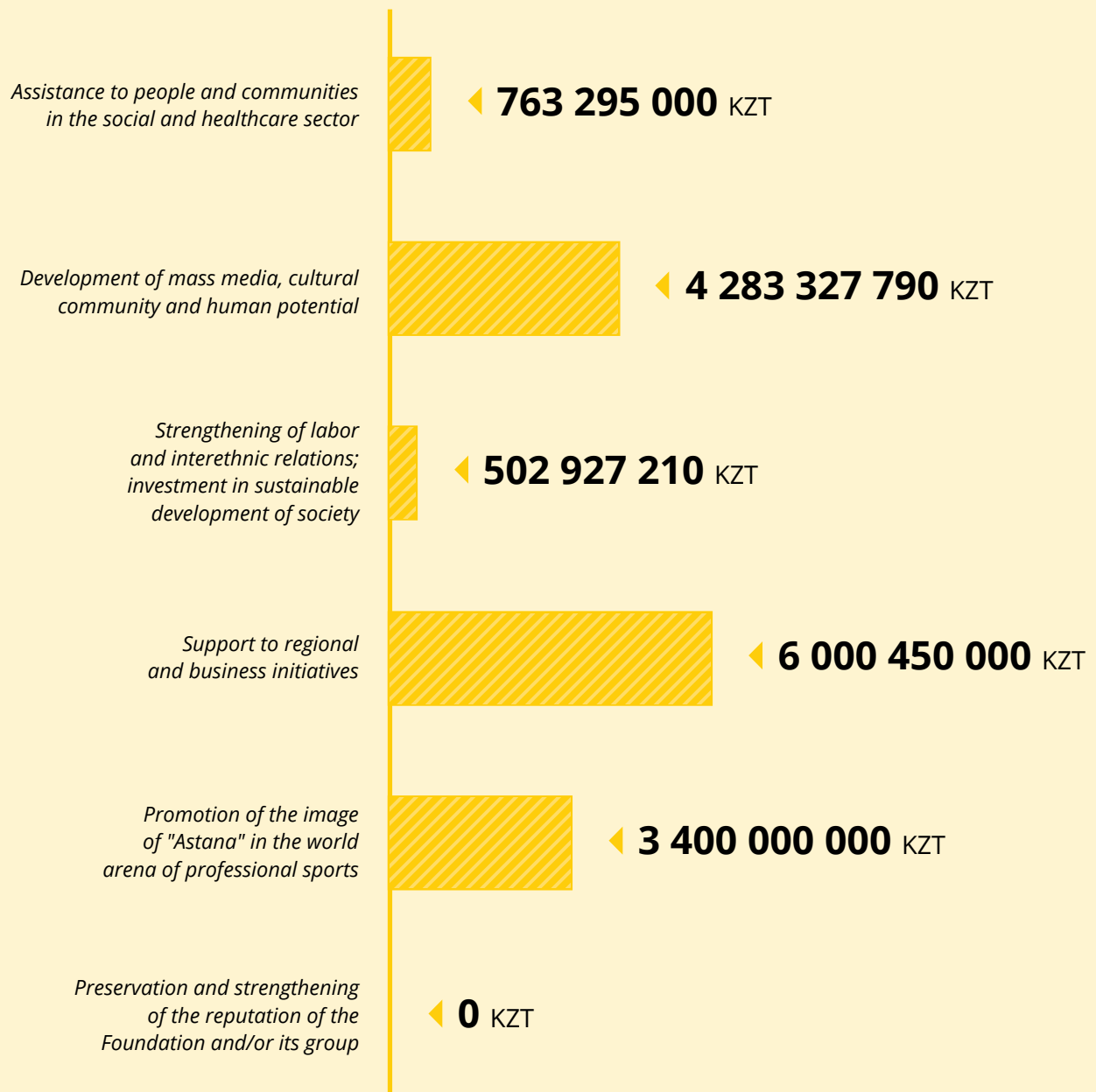
GENERAL INFORMATION ON SAMRUK-KAZYNA TRUST ACTIVITIES IN 2017

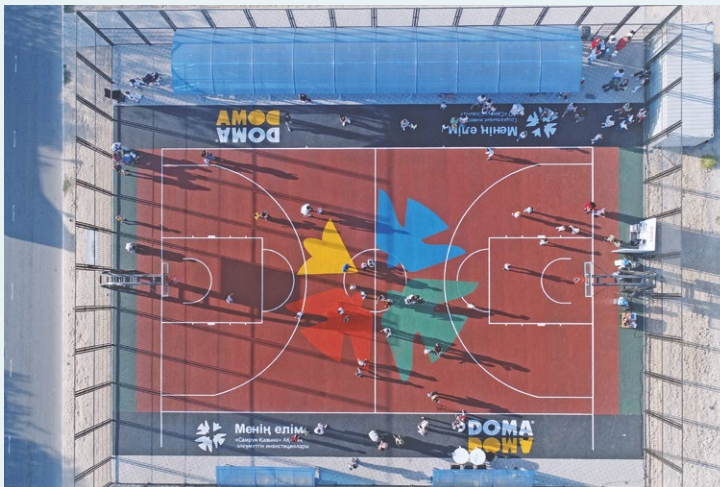
"Menin Elim" social investment program was first launched in 2016. The pilot projects in Arshaly and Akmol villages in Akmola region were implemented then. In 2017, the program was further developed and combined a number of projects focused on the improvement of the quality of life in the regions, where the member companies of the Fund operate. A number of special republic projects were also launched under the program: "Happy Childhood", "Children's Tourist Train "Tugan Elge Sayakhat", "Ozat" Scholarship Program", "Medical Trains".

Today, the "Menin Elim" program covers six regions of the Republic of Kazakhstan: Pavlodar, Mangistau, West Kazakhstan, Aktobe, Akmola, South Kazakhstan. The main benefit of the "Menin Elim" program is the involvement of the local population and local executive bodies into the implementation of the program. Mission of the program: improving the quality of life in the regions, scaling up access of the population to the high quality urban environment, education, healthcare, and cultural sites.

SOCIAL SUPPORT TO THE POPULATION



HEALTHY CHILDREN

To date, there are more than 19,000 children with infantile cerebral paralysis in Kazakhstan. Due to high load on medical centers, only 20% of such children can get rehabilitation and the rest have to wait for their turn for years.

As a result of the “Healthy Children” Project, 4 medical rehabilitation centers (MRC) for children with infantile cerebral paralysis from socially vulnerable categories of the population were established in Astana, Shymkent, Zhanaozen and Atyrau.

In 2017, the “Balapan” Early Intervention Center for children under the age of 2 with neuro-orthopedic disorders from low income families and orphan homes of Kazakhstan was opened in

“Healthy Children” is a project for the provision of a package of free rehabilitation services and qualified medical, social and psychological care to children with disabilities.

Project geography: cities of Astana, Shymkent, Atyrau, Zhanaozen

Administrators:

Target group: children with infantile cerebral paralysis from socially vulnerable categories of the population.

Astana with the support of Samruk-Kazyna Trust. The project includes various types of rehabilitation under an individual program: medical (kinesitherapy, exercise therapy with massage elements), pedagogical (correctional classes with a logopedist, speech pathologist, work therapy specialist) and psychological assistance.

The project is focused on a complex rehabilitation, giving an opportunity to achieve more efficient results.

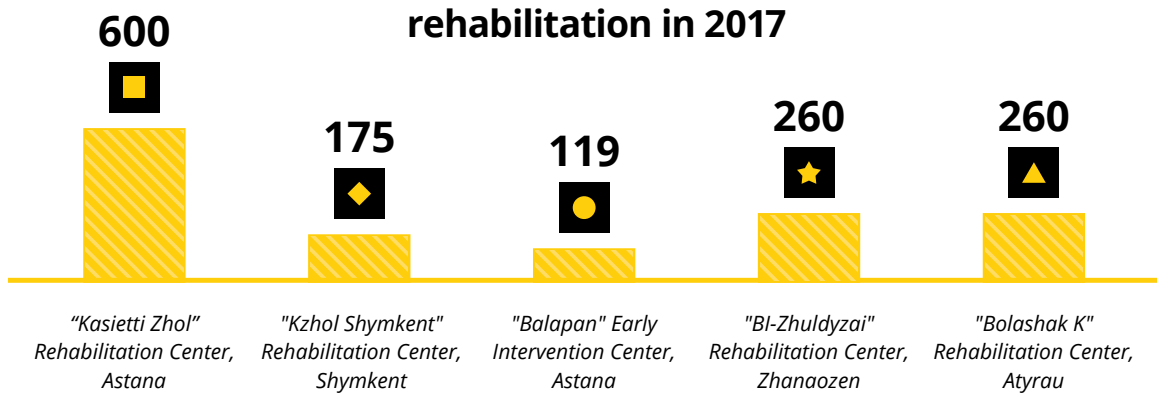
Effect: improved psychological and physical condition of 95% of children, the lack of improvement was noted only in children who missed classes.

FAMILY SUPPORT CENTER

“Family Support Center” is an experimental model of the Center for the support of adoptive families and families in difficult circumstances.

Project geography: city of Almaty and Almaty Region

Administrator: “Family Academy Complex Family Support Center” Public Foundation

Target groups: Orphans and children deprived of parental care, potential adoptive parents, actual adoptive parents, biological parents.

Annually, more than 700 parents are deprived of their parental rights, about 6,000 children are referred to the Adaptation Center for Minors, and more than half of them go to orphanages. The project is focused on the prevention of social orphanage, overcoming of negative stereotypes and creation of a positive image of orphans in the society.

As a result of the project, 4 groups graduated from the School of Adoptive Parents in Almaty and 2 groups in Talgar. The training programs

were developed for the psychologists who work with families in crisis situations and families, who decided to foster a child, adopt a child, etc.

Effect: professional development of personnel working in the area of social protection of children, improvement of public opinion and raising public awareness about destinies of orphans; increase in the number of orphans, who have received education, found good jobs and started their own families.

DIFFERENT – EQUAL

There are more than 150,000 children with special needs living in Kazakhstan. Only 27% of them go to ordinary schools, and 67% of children at the age from 3 to 6 have no access to the pre-school education. The Different-Equal Project was initiated in order to give every child, irrespective of his/her disabilities, an opportunity for development, education and living in the society of equal opportunities. The project is based on the idea of inclusion that is the process of getting people with disabilities truly involved in the active public life. Under the project, the facilities of psychological and pedagogical correction are opened in the regional centers of the Republic of Kazakhstan. In such facilities, a child gets a free complex assistance of a psychologist,

speech pathologist, massage specialist and other specialists.

More than 3,000 children with special needs and their families received help after opening of such correction facilities.

The equipment of correction facilities helps to provide all necessary conditions for the efficient development of children with special needs.

Effect: reduction in the number of persons, who need correction services, provision of opportunities for active transition to the inclusive education of children, who have been given access to the correctional services; multiplicative effect expressed in best practices of opening similar centers at the expense of businesses and the government.

“Different – Equal” is a project promoting the concept of inclusive society in Kazakhstan by creating equal education and development opportunities for children with disabilities.

Project geography: Republic of Kazakhstan

Administrator: “Dara” Private Foundation

Target groups: children with disabilities and their families.

GIFT OF LIFE TO CHILDREN

“Gift of Life to Children” is a project that helps children diagnosed with illnesses incurable in Kazakhstan to get medical treatment in foreign clinics.

Project geography: Republic of Kazakhstan

Administrator: “Mercy Volunteer Society”
Public Foundation

Target group: children diagnosed illnesses incurable in Kazakhstan

“Mercy Volunteer Society” Public Foundation deals with raising funds for medical treatment of children, searching for foreign medical clinics with high level of medical treatment at minimum cost, and sending children for surgery capable of stopping the progress of a disease or even cure it.

In 2017, under the project more than KZT 512 million were raised for the therapy of diseases incurable in Kazakhstan.

Effect: improvement of the domestic healthcare system through studying and analyzing the clinical records of children.

CARING HOME FOR A CHILD

“Caring Home for a Child” is a project for the support of family-type orphan homes.

Project geography: cities Almaty, Astana, Temirtau

Administrator: “SOS Kazakhstan Children’s Villages” Corporate Foundation

Target groups: orphans and children deprived of parental care.

The family-type orphan homes “SOS Children’s Villages” were supported under the “Caring Home for a Child” Project. These are special family-like forms for raising children deprived of parental care.

The Children’s Village consists of 10-12 family

homes. Each family lives in a separate house. The head of the family is a SOS-mother, who raises the children. Her observations help the team of specialists to identify strengths, develop the best traits of children and build independent personalities.

The project is being implemented in Almaty, Astana and Temirtau. In 2017, SOS Kazakhstan Children’s Villages with the support of Samruk-Kazyna Trust launched a number of new projects: “Family Support Center”, “SOS-Family Couple”, “Children’s Development Center”, “Asar” Mother and Child Center”, “Zhansaya Family”.

MEDICAL TRAINS

Medical trains have been travelling around Kazakhstan since 2010. In 2017, two medical trains were set in motion: “Salamatty Kazakhstan” and “Densaulyk”. Each train consisted of 8 rail cars equipped for the provision of diverse medical services and accommodation of personnel. Thanks to the project, the first-level and superior physicians in 10 medical areas could provide the medical examination and treatment services free of charge

to people living in remote locations of Kazakhstan. The mobile clinics were equipped with the modern mini-operating rooms and laboratories, modern diagnostic and therapeutic equipment, such as the computerized spirometry system and cardiological system, ultrasonic scanner, etc. **Effect:** improvement of the health condition of the population, especially of those, who have no access to high quality healthcare services.

“Medical Trains” is a project for running the medical trains to provide the high quality healthcare services to people living in remotely located stations and halts.

ZHENIS

Social and Charitable Project “Zhenis” was launched in 2015. At the initial stage of the project 5,083 veterans were provided with mobile phones with the “alert buttons” to call for an ambulance. Also, a website zhenys.kz was created to contain the information on the contribution of Kazakhstan people to the victory in the Great Patriotic War. The continual veteran care is promoted, the targeted assistance and financial assistance to all participants of the Great Patriotic War living in the Republic of Kazakhstan is provided all year round. “Zhenis” is the project of the republican scale aimed at strengthening

the patriotic spirit of the Kazakhstan society, promotion of spiritual and moral values, fostering of respectful attitude to the history and heroic deeds of veterans.

Effect: improvement of the living conditions of veterans and home front workers in collaboration with volunteers, including cleaning, purchasing of food products, medicines, furniture and appliances, minor repair; moral and historical education of 3,000 young people, who participated in the raids and events, 30% of which expressed a desire to be engaged in the volunteer activities under the project for the first time.

HOUSE OF HOPE

“House of Hope” is a project for the prevention of domestic violence among the population, provision of free help to victims of domestic violence.

Project geography: Aktau

Administrator: “Ray” Urgent Social Help Center” Private Institution

SPECIAL BOOKS FOR SPECIAL CHILDREN

In total, there are 420 blind children and 9,000 visually impaired children in Kazakhstan. The “Special Books for Special Children” Project was implemented to help blind and visually impaired children to study and perceive the surrounding world.

The use of tactile aids is the innovation tool used to develop the sense of touch of blind children. They are of great help to teachers who work with blind and visually impaired

children, and they are an efficient tool for making such children more social.

The layouts of special books are developed with due account for the recommendations of the Kazakhstan Ministry of Education and Science. The books were made in a special shop based on Kostanai Technical College. A set of books includes 15 units: 5 didactic books and 10 fairy tales.

“Special Books for Special Children” is a project for the supply of tactile aids and fiction books for blind and visually impaired children to specialized schools and pre-school education institutions of Kazakhstan.

KAZAKHSTAN WITHOUT ORPHANS

In 2013, there were more than 13,000 children in orphan asylums of Kazakhstan. In 2017, this number was reduced twofold and amounted to 6100. This happened, among other reasons, as a result of launching a unique website: usynovite.kz under the “Kazakhstan without Orphans” Project.

usynovite.kz is an on-line database of orphans and children deprived of parental care. The authors of the project were “Mercy” Volunteer Society Public Foundation and Samruk-Kazyna

Trust in collaboration with the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan and the Committee for the Protection of Children’s Rights.

The work on consulting and legal support in the adoption, foster care and guardianship cases was performed in 2017 under the “Kazakhstan without Orphans” Project.

Effect: an increase in the positive trend of more orphans being adopted.

“Defeating Autism” is a project to make autistic children more sociable by creating necessary conditions for the correct and timely diagnosis of this disease and rehabilitation of children.

Project geography: Republic of Kazakhstan

Administrator: “Mercy” Volunteer Society Public Foundation

Target group: children with autistic spectrum disorders and their parents.

The project was launched in 2013 to help children with autistic spectrum disorders to socialize. The conditions required for correct and timely diagnosis of the disease, consistent and regular rehabilitation of children are provided under the project.

The seminars on early diagnosis of the disease for personnel of public primary medical and pedagogical institutions became the key events of the project.

Also, the work is being carried out to improve

the level of understanding in families with autistic children and to change the stereotype attitude of parents and society. The children demonstrate improvements in muscular tonicity and eye contact thanks to the exercises.

Effect: better awareness of the population about autistic spectrum disorders and methods of their treatment; establishment of the Association of Parents of Children with Autism.

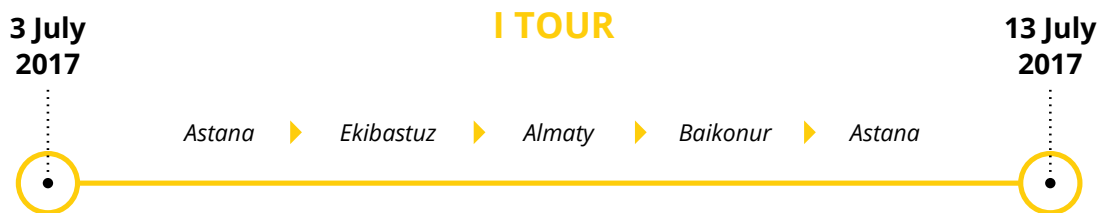

“Social Grants for Entrepreneurship” is a project for the provision of free grants for entrepreneurs with physical disabilities.

Project geography: Republic of Kazakhstan

Administrator: “Sharapat” Organization of Young People with Disabilities” Public Association

Target group: entrepreneurs with disabilities.

The project is aimed at creating favorable conditions for the professional fulfillment of people with disabilities. The gratuitous grants are allocated to develop and support business. The amount of financing per business idea does not exceed KZT 500,000. The application form for the participation in the project was available on the official website of “Sharapat” Organization at: moi-sharapat.kz. The project is implemented not only in the regional centers, but also in remote populated settlements.

For instance, the projects on opening a shop for the manufacture of clothes for kids in Almaty Region and a travel agency in Mangistau Region were implemented. **Effect:** financial stability of people with disabilities engaged in entrepreneurial activities, improvement of the situation with self-employment, changes in the psychological environment of the disabled through their adaptation and integration into society.

“ZhasMedia” is a project for the support and development of creative potential of young people who want to become journalists.

Project geography: Republic of Kazakhstan

Administrator: Kazakhstan Youth Congress Association of Legal Entities

Target group: young people at the age from 14 to 29, making their first steps in the carrier of journalists

Journalism schools were organized in six cities of Kazakhstan: Aktobe, Pavlodar, Aktau, Uralsk, Shymkent, Taldykorgan. 30 young journalists along with school and university students at the age from 14 to 29 dreaming to become journalists passed the competitive selection procedure.

The project was implemented by Samruk-Kazyna Trust jointly with the Kazakhstan Youth Congress and “SS Lab Tele-Laboratory”. The classes for young journalists in the regions were given by Sandi Sultan, a famous journalist, television anchorwoman and media trainer.

Project goals: increase of the education level of the young people living in the regions in the area of information and communication, promotion of the correct organization of leisure time of young people, boosting their social activity and improvement of useful public skills and abilities.

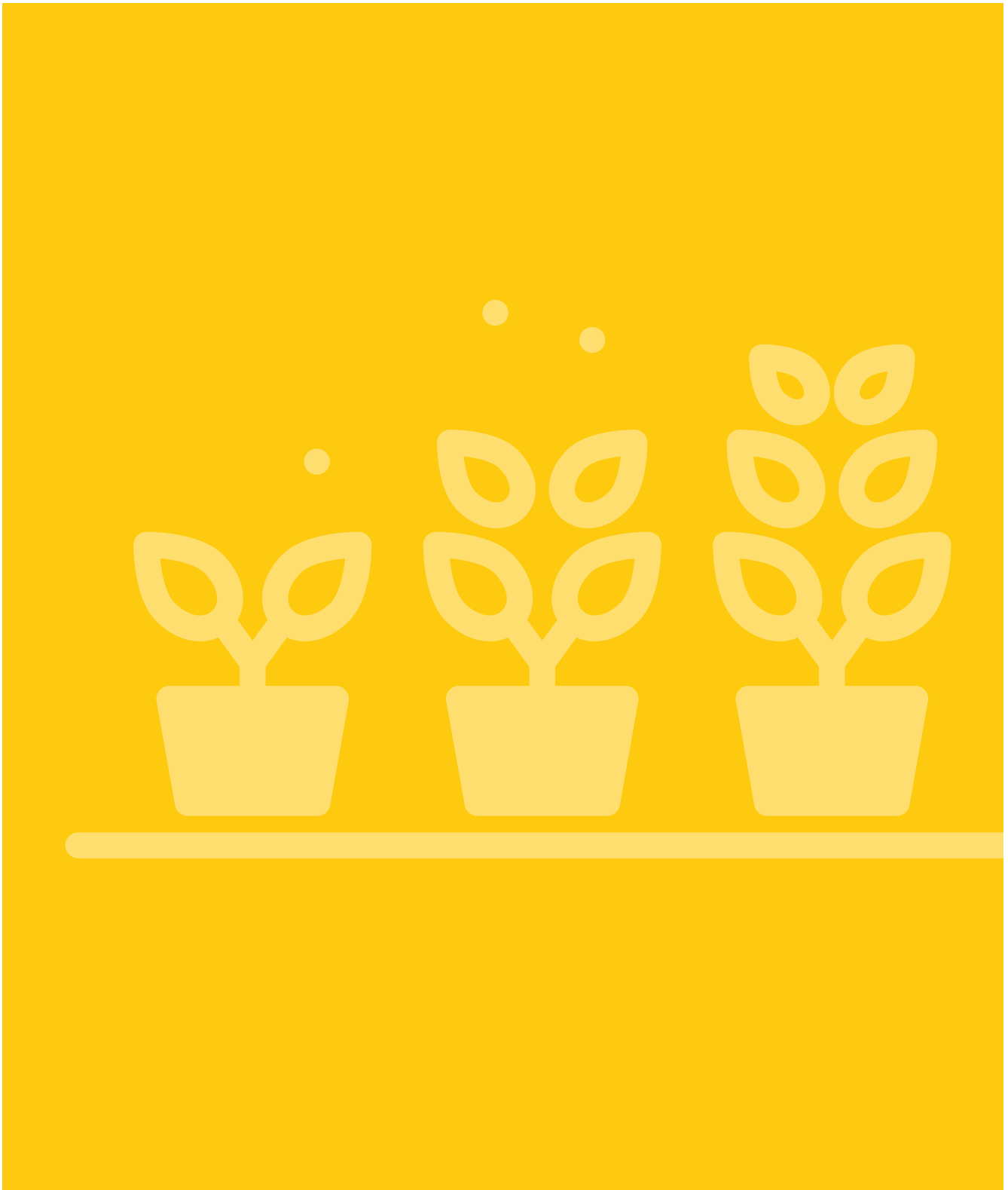

project, that renders support to children who need services of professional psychologists and speech pathologists.

Effect: initiating the work on establishing a legal framework for mentoring, development of training materials and methods for the implementation of the project in other regions of Kazakhstan.

All these and other questions became the subject of the discussion during the session.

The Foundation actively works on the preparation and dissemination of materials about the projects being implemented. In 2017, more than 5,000 publications about programs

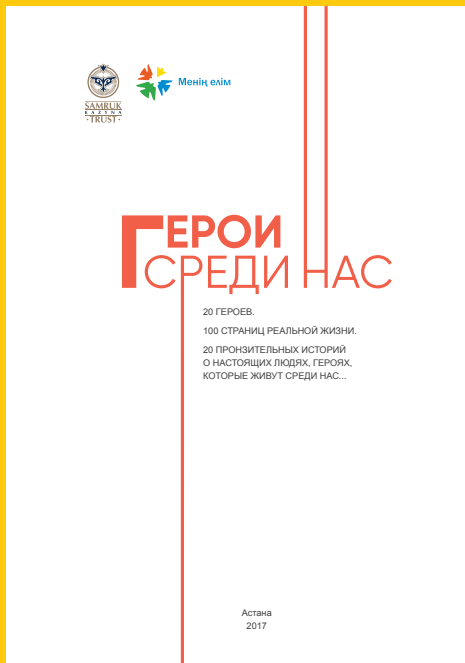
and events of the Foundation were placed in mass media and social networks. This indicator exceeds that for 2016 nearly twofold.

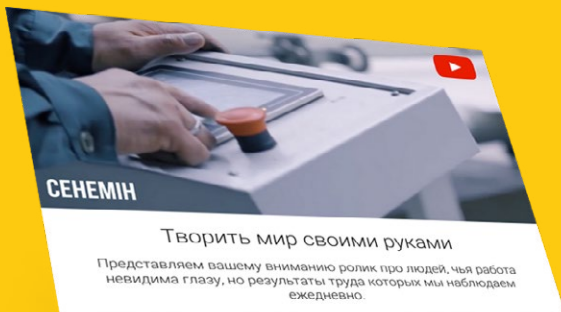
Music ME project
